2010 - 2011 FLES Classes

Introductory

- Open to all Kindergarten & 1st graders
- Classes meet once a week for 45 minutes before or after the school day
- 20 classes beginning in October

Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

- Sequential program open to 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th graders (Introductory level not a prerequisite for participation)
- Classes meet once a week for an hour before or after the school day
- 24 classes from October - May

Middle School

- Open to 6th graders who have participated in FLES in elementary school
- Classes meet once a week for an hour after the school day
- 24 classes from October - May

Tuition

- Competitive and affordable – \$240.00 per child for the school year
